

## Summer Enrichment Program 2018

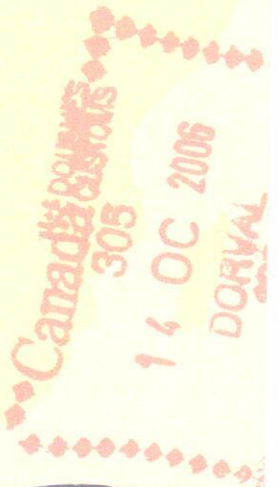
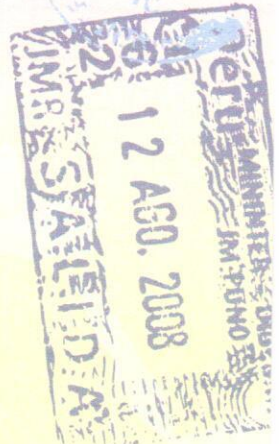
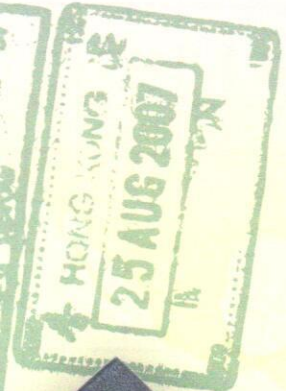

# Travel Schedule 2018

## June 6-19, 2018 Journey to Asia

Asia is a vast continent and takes up third of the entire world's land area, which automatically makes it the most populous continent on the planet! The multidisciplinary study of Asia will include students examining the unique biomes of the climate. Students will create cultural artifacts of the area such as Koi Kites, Abacus Making and Creating Japanese Fans. Students will explore the language and comparing its citizens rights, economics and educational structures. In addition to experiencing the unique culture through listening to the music, learning about the daily Life in Japan and learning to write their name in Chinese. The field trip planned this session is Birds of Prey. The culminating movie is Mulan.

## June 20-July 3, 2018 The America's Journey of Our Past and Present

The Americas include North and South American Continents. Educationally, students will compare and contrast living in Canada to living in America. They will not only learn what living in Canada would be like, understanding rights, economics, and governments, but they will learn to understand what it means to be an American. Our crafts will focus on the written languages and traditional art of each country. When studying the Americas, student will be taught cursive and/or calligraphy. Students will also create Mola Art, Dream Catchers, Mexican Art and Colonial Period Reconstructions. The field trip for this session will be The Winter Park Boat Tour and Sanford Museum. The culminating movie is Rio.

## July 5-July17, 2018 European Travels

Europe is a historical place. Countries in Europe share an eclectic culture of language, art and historical events making this country an exciting stop on our tour. The famous creator of the Rubik's Cube will be showcased and students will learn the mysteries on how to solve the cube. Students will create tissue paper collages about Europe, develop their own code of arms and practicing writing, learning and studying the meanings of their name from languages of the countries. Students will visit the Medieval Dinner Theater as a field trip to experience life in the middle ages. The culminating movie is Princess Bride.

## July 18-31, 2018 The African Safari

The continent of Africa brings a varied and artful history of development. Students will explore the art and math behind pyramids and the complexities of Egyptian Math. They will embark on the unique terrain and develop shadow pictures of the animals and backdrop of the country. Students will create African Inspired art and masks that represent a rich culture that varies from tribes to cities. Field trips in this session include a trip to the Orlando Wax Museum and the Orlando History Museum. The movie planned is Jungle Book.

## August 1-7, 2018 Culminating Activities and Trip to Epcot

Students will review the summer activities and prepare to plan for the school year, setting goals and minds to prepare. The final trip of the summer is Epcot.
