

The following procedures have been provided to address La Amistad's ongoing commitment to prioritize the safety of all patients and staff. La Amistad continues to review and implement changes based on the guidance of the CDC and our corporate infections control practitioners. The following procedures outlined below are subject to change as we continue to adjust to the ongoing needs.

Screening (temperature check & questionnaire)

- **Staff:** all staff will continue to be screened prior to entering the facility on both campuses until further notice
- **RTC Patients:** all patients will continue to be screened upon admission and twice daily while in treatment
- **PHP/IOP Patients:** all patients will be screened prior to entering the building on both campuses

Face Covering (procedural masks or cloth masks)

- **Staff:** all staff are required to wear face covering while in patient areas (see Activities section for exceptions).
- **PHP/IOP Patients:** all outpatient clients are required to wear face covering at all times while in patient areas during the course of their treatment day on both campuses (other than meal-time)
- **RTC Patients:** All RTC patients are required to wear a mask throughout the entirety of their stay at La Amistad except while eating meals.
- **Note:** all patients are being educated prior to entering treatment as to the face covering expectation. In the event a patient refuses to follow the above procedures, then the patient should be immediately isolated and clinical leadership contacted.

Social Distancing

- **Winter Park (adults):** the cafeteria seating has been intentionally spread out in order to comply with 6 feet of social distancing. Social distancing is practiced in group activities.
- **Maitland (adolescents):** the cafeteria seating has been intentionally spread out in order to comply with 6 feet of social distancing. Social distancing is practiced in group activities.

Activities

- **Winter Park & Maitland:** patients are permitted to remove mask for outdoor activities such as swimming and recreational therapy. At this time patients are asked to maintain a 6 foot distance for staff or peers.
